- B; text continues from card A; by Earl Norem; same front image as #56 above, but is horizontal with a red background and a different back...\$6

MARS ATTACKS POCKET COMICS (1988) Pocket Comics/Topps. Set number n.k. These cards are from the bottom of the second box of *Mars Attacks Pocket Comics*, but they look to be professionally cut.
